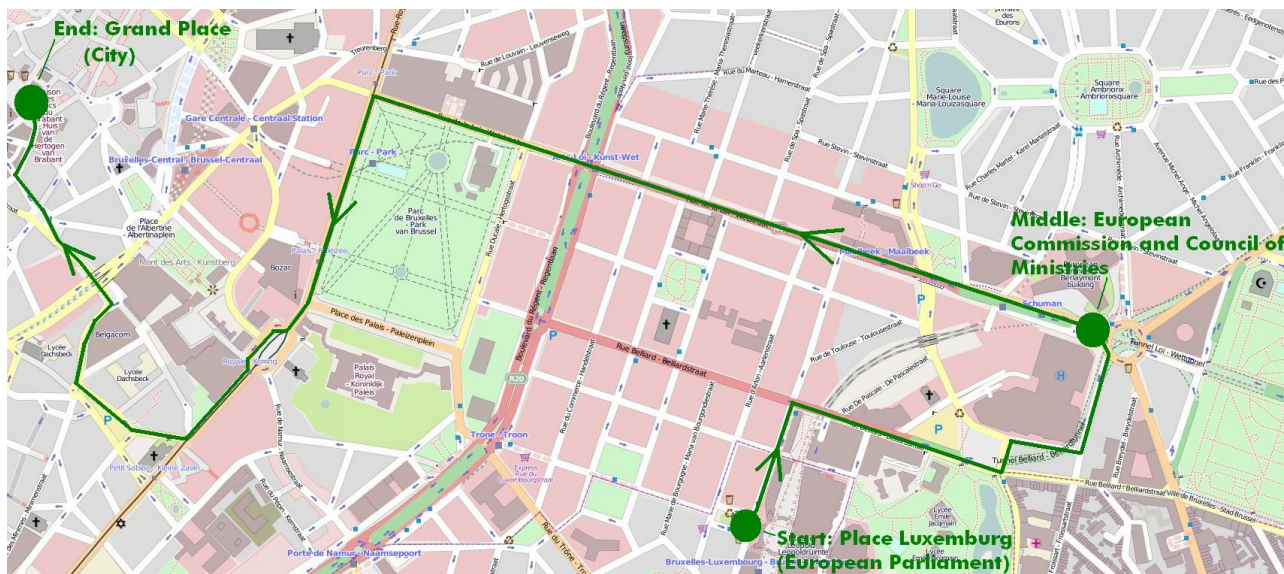
Time of demonstration start: 14:00 (2 pm)

Course of the demonstration:

- Starting with some speeches and announcement on Place du Luxembourg
- Walking via Rue de Treves, Rue Belliard, Place Jean Rey, Justus Lipsiusstraat, Rue Froissart, Grand circle, Rue de la Loi to the small circle between Berlaymont and Council of ministries (Place Schuman).
- Intermediate stop at Place Schuman with speeches and announcements.
- Walking via Rue de la Loi, Rue Royale, Place Royale, Rue de la Regence, Rue Bodenbroeck, Place du Grand Sablon, Rue Lebeau, Rue de l'Hopital, Place Saint Jean, Rue de la Violette, Rue de Chapeliers to the Grand Place.
- Closing event at the Grand Place, speeches, announcements, including interrupts of political music slots.
